During the Summer holiday the existing Nursery class will be refurbished with new windows, flooring and increased classroom space. The Early years outdoor space will be completely transformed all ready for September, with new outdoor seating, a circular storytelling tree and new artificial grass areas.



It's also full steam ahead within main school too, with the transformation of the existing Reception classrooms into Year 1 classrooms. 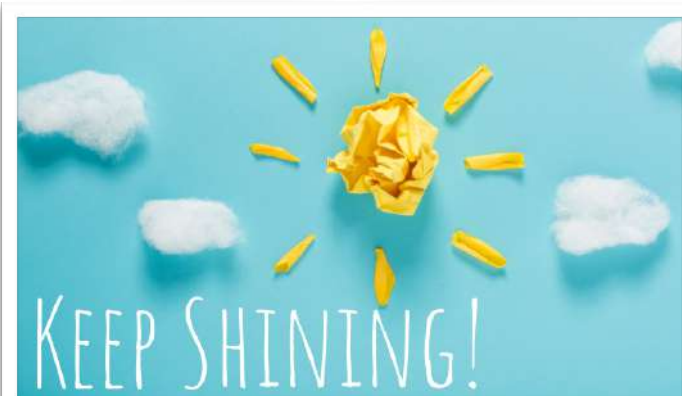


... and finally
