Maths

This week we have introduced the children to estimation. The children needed to have a 'clever guess' without counting the objects being held in the adults hand. The children had some great guesses.

Perhaps your child could estimate something at home e.g. how many chips they have on their plate.

Threading

This week the children have been talking about their favourite fruit and they have have cut around the shape of their favourite fruit. They then used the hole punch to create holes around the edge of the paper fruit and then lastly, they used wool to thread in and out of the holes. This was all great fine motor skills practice!
