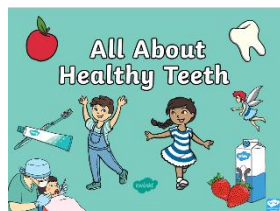

Templemoor Election

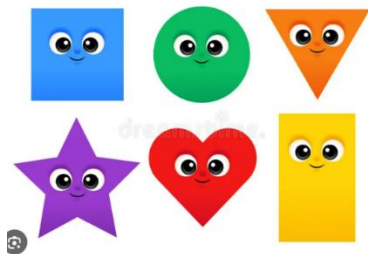


Templemoor

for real 2D shape examples eg a rectangular table,

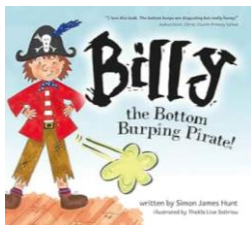
circular light etc. What shapes can your child find at home? E.g. a remote control (rectangle), a plate (circle), cushion (square) etc.
