Phonics



We have now taught the children all of the Set I letter sounds. The children will now be assessed to see which sounds they know. We will then revisit certain sounds and continue with other phonics activities.

## EURO 2024



This week we have been revisiting the numerals I to 5. The children also needed to use their fingers to make the numbers I to 5. We also revisited subitising to 5. Subitising is recognising how many objects there are without counting them.
